HOW TO PREVENT RECORDING IN ZOOM

The BSA <u>Digital Safety and Online Scouting Activities</u> page states, "Do not record online activities/meetings that include youth participants." Some examples include pack/den meetings, troop/patrol meetings, Scoutmaster conferences, and Boards of Review. This policy also applies to any portions of a roundtable that may involve youth, such as the opening and closing or presentations given by youth, *unless certain criteria are met*. 
PREVENT RECORDING IN ZOOM IN TWO STEPS


By default, Zoom allows recording by both the host and participants, and it is not obvious how to turn off that capability. Hosts of online activities/meetings should turn off the recording option as follows:

1. Sign In to Zoom


The Recording option can only be turned off from the zoom.us website. It cannot be turned off in the settings in the Zoom app or with the controls available within the videoconference. Prior to starting the videoconference, the host needs to sign in to the zoom.us website in one of two ways:

- Directly at https://zoom.us/signin, or
- If signed into the Zoom app, navigate to Settings > General and click View More Settings.






The **Sign In** page will be displayed. Sign in to your Zoom account.




2. Update Recording Settings


On the **PERSONAL: Settings** screen, click the **Recording** tab:



Click the toggle for the Local recording setting so that the Record option will not be displayed during any videoconference that you host.



Hosts with a paid Zoom account also need to turn off the **Cloud recording** setting:




After making those changes, the Record option shown below will no longer be displayed for the host or participants during a Zoom meeting:




If you have a paid Zoom license plan with *multiple hosts*, the settings can be changed for all hosts.

On the **ADMIN: Account Settings** screen, click the **Recording** tab:



Click the toggles for the **Local recording** and **Cloud recording** settings so that the **Record** option will not be displayed during any videoconference by any host on your account.



RECORDING YOUTH IN A VIRTUAL CAMP SETTING

Councils who are coordinating a virtual camping experience may record youth as part of their Councilcoordinated virtual camp(s). This recording permission does not apply to unit level activities. Units must continue to follow the policy detailed in Digital Safety and Online Scouting Activities.
