### Easy Chocolate Silk Pie for Cub Scouts

#### Ingredients:

- 1 pre-made pie crust (graham cracker, chocolate cookie or regular pie crust)
- 2 packages instant pudding and pie filling (3.4 to 3.9oz)
- 2  $\frac{3}{4}$  cup cold 2% milk
- 2 cups whipped cream or 2 cups whipped frozen topping
- optional garnish: chocolate or rainbow sprinkles

#### Instructions:

1. Prepare the pie crust as directed (if baking, cool completely).
2. In a large bowl, combine the pudding mix and milk. Whip for two minutes. Pour into the pie shell.
3. Refrigerate for two hours.
4. Top with whipped cream or whipped topping and sprinkles.
