



INTERNATIONAL SCOUTER'S AWARD



The International Scouter's Award encourages Scouters to broaden their involvement in Scouting through participation in world Scouting activities, recognizes adult leaders for their contributions to world Scouting, and raises awareness of Scouting in local councils.

The award can be earned by registered Scouting America adult leaders. All requirements must be earned during tenure as a registered adult leader. The application must be approved by the Council International Representative and the Council Scout Executive.

I. Giving Leadership to International Scouting

Date Completed

_____ Serve as a Council International Representative for a minimum of two consecutive years.

_____ Serve as a Council International Committee member or as a member of the Scouting America International Committee for a minimum of three consecutive years.

_____ Serve as a registered adult leader at the Unit, District or Council level in the Direct Service Council, Far East Council, or Transatlantic Council.

_____ Serve a term as a member of the Interamerican Scout Committee or in an Interamerican Region volunteer position for a minimum of three consecutive years.

_____ Serve a term as a member of the World Scout Committee or in a WOSM volunteer position for a minimum of three consecutive years.

II. Giving Leadership to International Events Held in the U.S.

Date Completed

_____ Host Scouts/Adult Leaders (minimum of three visitors per group) from another country at your local council camp as part of an official Unit, District, Council or National activity. [Please note that hosting in private homes is not considered an official Scouting activity.]

_____ Serve on the International Staff at a National Scout Jamboree.

_____ Assist with coordinating the International Camp Staff Program (send welcome email, arrange for ground transportation to camp, etc.). Partner with Council professional staff and camp leadership to arrange to have an international Scout serve on your Council's summer camp staff for at least one summer camp season.

_____ Help organize and participate in two Jamboree-on-the-Air (JOTA) or Jamboree-on-the-Internet (JOTI) events.

III. Giving Leadership to International Events Held in Other Countries

Date Completed

_____ Serve as an adult leader as part of a Scouting America contingent to a World Scout Jamboree, World Scout Moot, Interamerican Scout Jamboree, or a WOSM Region event conducted by any WOSM Region.

_____ Serve as an adult leader for a group of Scouting America Scouts participating in an event held by an International Scout Association recognized by the World Organization of the Scout Movement (WOSM). The activity may be an exchange program, a camp experience, or a tour activity.

_____ Serve on the International Service Team (IST) Staff at a World Scout Jamboree, World Scout Moot, Interamerican Scout Jamboree, or a WOSM Region event conducted by any WOSM Region.

IV. Educating Self and Others

Date Completed

_____ Attend an International Scouting conference or training event conducted by the Scouting America International Committee. Share what you have learned with others in your Council.

_____ Promote International Scouting at a Unit, District, Council, Territory or National event.

_____ Participate in organizing or providing leadership for a Scouting America Scout activity in another country that involves interaction with Scouts from that country, such as an exchange program, camping experience, or a tour activity.

_____ Earn the International Spirit Award or encourage and support at least two Scouts earn the International Spirit Award.

_____ Organize and participate in a Messengers of Peace project. Earn a Messengers of Peace Award.

V. Giving Support to International Scouting

_____ Organize a collection for the World Friendship Fund at two Unit, District or Council events.

_____ Become or recruit a member of the Order of the Condor of the Interamerican Scout Foundation.

_____ Become or recruit a Baden-Powell Fellow of the World Scout Foundation.

_____ Become or recruit a member of the Kandersteg International Scout Centre (KISC) Association or donate to a KISC Fundraising Project of the KISC Foundation.

_____ Become or recruit a Gilwell Fellow of the Gilwell Park Development Fund.

Award Submission and Processing Instructions

After approval by the Council International Representative (IR) and the Council Scout Executive, the Council IR works with the Council Registrar to have the award entered into the applicant's Scouting America profile via the Scouting America database. The award is listed in the database under the "Other Awards" heading with the award name "International Scouter's Award". The award date entered should be the date the award was approved by the Council IR.

Upon approval and recording in the database, the signed and dated application must be submitted to the Scouting America International Committee for National award records. The application is required to be filed with the National office before the applicant may be recognized as a recipient. Send signed and scanned form to: international@scouting.org with the Subject Line: International Scouter's Award - Council Name.

Upon Receipt of National registry acknowledgment, the Council International Representative is responsible for ordering the recognition items in coordination with Council professional staff. Recognition items are an International Scouter's Award certificate (SKU # 656275) and a purple and white knot (SKU # 618969). Please note, the knot is to be worn above the left pocket with the purple to the right. The certificate and knot should be presented to the recipient at a prominent District or Council function.
